Organized NET/SET WORKSHOP





म. स. गा. महाविद्यालय मालेगाव कॅम्प, नाशिक अर्थशास्त्र विभागा द्वारे आयोजित व्याख्यानाचा अहवाल

19 सप्टेंबर 2019 रोजी अर्थशास्त्र विभागाद्वारे पदव्युत्तर वर्गाच्या विद्यार्थ्यांसाठी व्याख्यानाचे आयोजन करण्यात आले. महिलारत्न पुष्पाताई हिरे महिला महाविद्यालयातील अर्थशास्त्र विभाग प्रमुख डॉ. बी. एम. सोनवणे यांना व्याख्याते म्हणून बोलविण्यात आले. 'भारतीय अर्थव्यवस्थेसमोरील मंदीचे सावट' या विषयावर डॉ. सोनवणे यांनी अभ्यासपूर्ण व्याख्यान दिले. या कार्यक्रमाच्या अध्यक्षस्थानी महाविद्यालयाचे प्राचार्य डॉ. दिनेश शिरोडे हे उपस्थित होते.

पदव्युत्तर वर्गातील विद्यार्थ्यांसमोर बोलताना डॉ. सोनवणे यांनी भारताची आणि जागतिक अर्थव्यवस्थेची सद्यस्थिती विद्यार्थ्यांना स्पष्ट करून सांगितली. जागतिक पातळीवर निर्मित वस्तूंना मागणी कमी झालेले असल्यामुळे उद्योजकांच्या वस्तू अपेक्षेनुसार विकल्या जात नाही. अत्याधुनिक तंत्रज्ञानाचा वापर उत्पादन क्षेत्रात अधिक प्रमाणात वाढू लागलेला आहे. आधुनिक तंत्रज्ञान विकसित करणे किंवा ते विकत घेऊन त्याचा वापर उत्पादनाच्या प्रक्रियेत करून घेणे यासाठी खर्चाच्या प्रमाणात मोठ्या प्रमाणात वाढ झालेली असल्यामुळे वस्तूंच्या किमती या सरासरी 20 ते 25 टक्क्यांनी वाढलेले आहेत. याचा परिणाम असा झालेला आहे मध्यमवर्गीय ग्राहकांनी त्यांची वस्तूंना असणारी मागणी अनिश्चित कालावधीसाठी पुढे ढकलली आहे. युरोपातील काही अर्थव्यवस्था त्यांच्या उत्पादनापेक्षा विकास इतर खर्च अधिक करताना विसून येत आहेत. म्हणूनच ग्रीस या देशाने स्वतःची दिवाळखोरी जाहीर केलेली आहे. जगातील चंगळवादी अर्थव्यवस्थांच्या दृष्टीने हा धोक्याचा इशारा आहे. म्हणून अर्थव्यवस्थांना खर्च नियंत्रणात राखण्यासाठी धोरणात्मक निर्णय घेऊन त्याची अंमलबजावणी करावी लागेल. जागतिक आर्थिक घडामोडींचा भारतासारख्या संवेदनशील अर्थव्यवस्थांवर परिणाम होतो. भारताचा आर्थिक विकासाचा दर हा

प्रामुख्याने शेती क्षेत्राच्या विकासावर ही अवलंबून असतो. परंतु शेती क्षेत्रातील उत्पादनवाढीचा दर हा दोन टक्क्यांपेक्षा खाली घसरलेला असल्यामुळे. शेती क्षेत्रावर विसंबून असणाऱ्या शेतकरी व शेतमजुरांच्या उत्पन्न व रोजगार यावर प्रतिकूल परिणाम झालेला दिसून येतो. यामुळे भारतातील जवळपास 50 टक्क्यांपेक्षा अधिक लोकांची क्रयशक्ती घटलेली असल्यामुळे भारतात देखील उत्पादित मालाला उठाव कमी आहे. म्हणूनच की काय भारतात देखील मंदिर सदश्य परिस्थिती निर्माण झालेली आहे. यासाठी शासनाला सर्वसामान्य व निम्न उत्पन्न स्तरातील तसेच असंघटित क्षेत्रातील व्यक्तींच्या उत्पन्नात वाढ होईल या पद्धतीची घीरणे आखावी लागतील जेणेकरून भारतीय अर्थव्यवस्था मंदीच्या छायेत जाण्यापासून वाच् शकेल.

मसगा महाविद्यालयातील अर्थशास्त्र विभाग प्रमुख डॉ. एम. व्ही. हिरे यांनीदेखील विद्यार्थ्यांना मार्गदर्शन केले. महाविद्यालयीन जीवनातच विद्यार्थ्यांनी जागतिक पटलावर घडणाऱ्या हार्दिक घडामोडींचा बारकाईने अभ्यास केल्यास आर्थिक विश्लेषण करण्याचा लवीन दृष्टिकोन विद्यार्थ्यांमध्ये वृद्धिंगत होऊ शकतो यासाठी सालत्यपूर्ण प्रयत्नांची आवश्यकता आहे. कार्यक्रमाचे स्वसंचालन अर्थशास्त्र विभागातील वरिष्ठ प्रा. डॉ. आर. के. जाघव यांनी केले. व्याख्यानासाठी अर्थशास्त्र विभागातील सर्व प्राध्यापक व पदव्युत्तर वर्गाचे सर्व विद्यार्थी उपस्थित होते.

Seminar on Union Budget 2023-24 (Academic year -2022-23)

Report

A seminar on Union Budget 2023-24 was organized by the Department of Economics at Maharaja Sayajirao Arts, Science and Commerce College, Malegaon-Camp Gaikwad Nashik, on 10 February 2023. Mahilaratna Pushpatai Hiray Women's College Head of Economics Department Smt. Dr. Meena F. Patil was present as the keynote speaker and she analyzed the Union Budget in detail. The opening ceremony of the seminar was presided over by the principal of the college Dr. S. N. Nikam was present. On this occasion, Vice Principal of the college Dr. T. S. Sawle, Halwar, Academic Supervisor Dr. Pravin Patil was Dr. D. K. The purpose of organizing the seminar was introduced HOD present. of the Economics by Dr. B. M. Sonawane explained.

"The central budget has made efforts for the overall development of the country's economic, social, educational, health, agriculture, industry, service sector, cultural, defence, organized and unorganized sectors. Government has taken measures for digital University, new appointments of teachers and also decided to start new educational channels for students. However, the provision of expenditure on education is not sufficient compared to the GDP, so the improvement and quality of education sector will not increase as expected Smt. Dr. Mina Patil expressed this. On this occasion the Vice Principal Dr. T. S. Savle ehile commenting on the Union Budget, Savale said that the Union Budget is a subject that is close to everyone's. A common man first thinks about which consumer goods will become cheaper and which goods will become more expensive due to the Union Budget. A farmer first thinks about the facilities and subsidy provided by the government for the agricultural sector. But it is more important to know what provisions the government has made in the budget for the overall development of the country.

Post-graduate students expressed their views on the budget in the afternoon session of the seminar. The experts gave satisfactory answers to the questions asked by the students on this occasion. 68 PG and UG level students participated in the seminar. The seminar concluded with the National Anthem.

Guest Lecture on Climate Change and Crop Pattern Repo (2022-23) Report

An Interdisciplinary Guest Lecture on 'Climate Change and Cropping Pattern' was organized by the Department of Economics on 17 January 2023. Dr. A. D. Pawar, subject expert and research guide of the college's geography department, was the keynote speaker. The program was presided over by N. D. Pagar, Senior Professor, Department of Political Science, of the College. Dr. M. V. Hiray, Senior Professor, Department of Economics, introduced the keynote speakers. And Dr. B. M. Sonawane, HOD of Economics explained the purpose of organizing the lecture in the introduction.

Dr. A. D. Pawar in his lecture explained the information in a scientific manner regarding the geographical location, seasonal cycle and cropping system of India. As India falls in the temperate zone, there are mainly three seasons in India. Farmers produce different crops during Kharif and Rabi seasons. When farmers were farming in traditional way, traditional crops were cultivated in large scale. Certain crops were cultivated in an environment conducive to the crops.

This makes certain regions famous for the production of certain crops. E.g. Nagpur's oranges, Nashik's grapes, Jalgaon's bananas and the production of cereal crops in North India, etc., but in the last three decades, a large amount of trees were felled in the name of industrialization and due to the increase in the speed of industrialization, air, water and noise pollution were created in a large amount. The emission of chemical elements started increasing. Dr. A. D. Pawar explained in his lecture that this resulted in increase in temperature and due to this there are drastic changes in the cropping system as well.

Dr. D. N. Sonawane, Dr. S. P. Deore, Dr. R. K. Jadhav and 46 students of the Department of Economics were present for the lecture. Samadhan Gumade, a postgraduate student of the Department of Economics expressed his thanks.
