### Kargil Vijay Divas

On July 26<sup>th</sup>, 1999, courageous Indian soldiers reclaimed many heights in the Himalayas that had been occupied by Pakistani intruders in Kashmir. This day commemorates our warriors' victories and sacrifices. The Kargil war, one of the most major wars in Indian history, was fought between May and July 1999 in the Kargil-Drass sector of Jammu and Kashmir, when Pakistani soldiers illegally entered certain areas along the Line of Control (LoC). This three-month-long conflict between the two nations has become profoundly ingrained in both nations' consciousness. The Indian Army began Operation Vijay to retake control of the areas seized by Pakistan. Sadly, about 500 soldiers were martyred during this extended struggle.

The event started with a brief introduction of Kargil Vijay Divas by Lt. B.B. Waghmare. Activities such as the Voluntary Oratorical Speech were held to instill patriotism in the cadets while also sharpening their creativity.
