- O Key points of the lecture:

Ghalib is a genius poet of his time. Ghalib was the greatest poet of the world in his time. If Ghalib was only a prose writer, his name

would have survived in Urdu literature. Traveling to Calcutta is an important part of Ghalib's life.

o Key points of the lecture:
